- Dressage tests for October Dressage Show will be judged by Shari Wolke, **all classes marked with an asterisk (non-dressage tests) will be judged by a Meadowlark Instructor**

- Ribbons will be awarded to places 1-6 in each class. Ties will be broken using collective marks.
- Meadowlark School Horses are available to Meadowlark students only, on a first-come-first-served basis and students may be required to share a school horse with others.
- Riders should list a division, and classes will be split by division if numbers allow. Riders may sign up for multiple different Tests of Choice within the same class, and if enough riders sign up for the same test, a separate class will be formed. Horses listed as Green should have limited experience under-saddle and be in their first season of showing.
- Current negative coggins is required for all horses hauling in. SEI approved helmets must be worn by **all** riders when mounted, and safe footwear is required for all classes. Formal attire is suggested, but definitely not required. **Helmets must be worn during costume class, if mounted!**
- For ride times, please text Emily no earlier than 48 hours prior to show start at (734) 776-8103.
- All Intro tests will be ridden in the small arena. Training level tests will be in the **small or large** arena (at management's discretion), and First/Second level tests will be ridden in the large arena.
